Transportation:

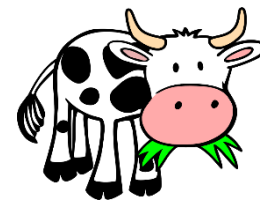
People travel daily near and far. The modes of transportations: land, air and water. Let us learn more about traveling by trains, bus, ships and airplanes
